

Your final paper

Each workshop is 90 minutes duration and within that time 3 papers are allocated (although this can sometimes be 2 or 4). This gives 30 minutes to each paper, of which 20 is for the presentation and 10 to take questions/discussion.

Your final paper is uploaded via a link given to you in an email by the conference office – this email will be sent on or around mid-March. Your paper can be any length, contain maps, tables, graphs and images. If you would like to be considered for the Best Paper Award it will need to be uploaded by 4th April 2010. If you would like it to be posted on our website before the start of the conference please upload by 3rd May 2010. Papers received after this date may be loaded after the conference.
