Advice for the Higher Education Institution Letter of Support

The Higher Education Institution (HEI) is required to send a supporting letter on headed notepaper addressing the following areas:

Warranty on the following:

- that the person is eligible to apply for the RSA Early Career Grant Scheme
- that the person signing the letter has the authority to do so
- that the HEI research ethics and other appropriate guidelines apply
- that the HEI health and safety rules apply
- that there are appropriate insurances in place
- that the provision of additional support is in place in the form of, but not exclusively limited to, office space, computing and related equipment and support, library facilities
- that the HEI will manage the financial arrangements for the grant and allow its portability in the event that this is necessary and approved by the Regional Studies Association
